SCHEDULE:

- 1) The sport of cowboy mounted shooting
- 2) CMSA and Northern Illinois Outlaws membership information
- 3) Northern Illinois Outlaws events
- 4) Period correct clothing and accessories
- 5) Gun requirements, gun models, gun leather, gun safety
- 6) Shooting practice from the ground
- 7) Course management
- 8) Lunch break – Lunch provided
- 9) Horsemanship (**horse must neck rein**)
- 10) Conditioning your horse to gunfire
- 11) Shooting on horseback

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:

- 1) Horse and tack (**horse must neck rein**)
- 2) Widest belt that fits you
- 3) Gun belts and holsters (optional)
- 4) Single action revolvers in .22 or .45 long colt caliber (optional)
- 5) Lawn chair
- 6) Horse ear plugs (optional)
- 7) Rider ear plugs (optional)
- 8) Rider helmet (optional)
- 9) Negative Coggins test within the last twelve months
Out of state horses are required to have a current health certificate
- 10) Illinois residents should have a valid Firearm Owners Identification (FOID) card.
- 11) All horses must be stalled for morning session. One stall included with clinic fee. Additional stalls are available for \$10.00 per day.

Notice: **Loaner revolvers and holsters are available** with proof of valid FOID card (FOID applies to Illinois residents only.)

RULES:

- 1) No live ammunition on grounds
- 2) No stud horses
- 3) No dogs
- 4) Release form must be signed before participating
